

# **SKippy's** Expectations for Skippy's The Range Vacation Care

The Range OSHC <u>Excursion information:</u> Book in quick to avoid missing out! Please note: all excursions are capped as stated on the vacation care program. This will vary depending on excursion. It will be a requirement on booking that permission forms are signed to confirm booked excursions that your child will be attending. If there is no permission form signed, your child will be unable to attend excursions.

<u>Sun Safety Policy including SunSmart Clothing and Hats:</u> I would like to bring to everyone's attention our "Sun Protection Policy" (available for viewing upon request.) This policy contains crucial information regarding the policy that Skippy's ELC enforces to ensure the health and safety of all children and educators.

Please see below acceptable clothing for all children taken from above policy-

'Ensure that their child's clothing provides adequate protection from UVR. Cancer Council Queensland recommends clothing with the following features:

- Dark-coloured
- Collars and sleeves
- Closely woven fabric
- Natural fibre

If your child comes dressed in inappropriate clothing such as singlets or dresses with no sleeves, your child will be asked by educators to change into SunSmart clothing before going outside. If your child does not have alternative clothing in their bag your child will not be able to go outside.' This is the procedure that we currently follow if a child does not bring their hat.

To ensure adequate sun protection for your child please ensure your child brings a broad brimmed hat every day. NO CAPS! If your child does not bring one, they may miss out on activities planned in the outdoor environment or excursions.

<u>Enclosed Shoes:</u> Please ensure that your child brings enclosed shoes everyday as we may participate in experiences in the carpentry shed that require enclosed shoes. In addition, our excursion policy states it is a requirement for all children to wear enclosed shoes while on excursion. If they do not bring enclosed shoes, they will not be able to attend the excursions.

Water bottles, spare set of clothes and a bag: Please ensure that your child brings a water bottle and a bag every day. This ensures that your child's belongings are kept together, and a drink of water is easily accessible throughout the day. During vacation care we like to spontaneously offer water play experiences throughout the day, if you would like your child to participate in these experiences please pack a spare set of clothing or togs including swimming rashie and a towel.
