Specialist Areas

Music: Students will learn the Ukulele through the Fun Music Ukulele program. Students will learn how to play chords, finger-pick melodies, play as an ensemble, and sing and play their ukulele simultaneously.

Physical Education: Students will be engaged in a Major Games unit of learning where they will enjoy regular movement-based learning experiences and understand and appreciate their significance to personal, social, cultural, environmental and health practices and outcomes. The annual Ball Games Carnival will provide them with an enjoyable means of demonstrating the skills they have learnt throughout the term.

Our Asian neighbours:

Students will explore the diverse environments, people's and cultures within the Asia region and expand their mental map of the world. Students will examine Australia's various connections with our Asian neighbours and the effects of these interconnections. They will compare and contrast economics, demographics, and social characteristics of countries across the Asian Region.

Care and Health

Using the My Wellbeing Journal students discuss ways to identify stress and anxiety in situations, and methods of dealing with jealousy and envy. Students participate in whole school programs of sisters, committees and houses. They also create a term for the goal and are given the opportunity to work on this goal during class. Homework and weekly planning are completed collaboratively to begin instilling this important habit.
