CARE PROGRAM

Our Pastoral Care Program facilitates positive social, emotional development by focusing on key areas of student well-being. With a Deputy Principal dedicated to overseeing pastoral care along with camps and excursions, the social and emotional well-being of all girls is nurtured in a safe and caring environment.





PREP

Prep at Girls Grammar provides our youngest students the opportunity to excel in a small, caring environment where their individual potential can be nurtured. The curriculum is stimulating and exciting, promoting emergent literacy and numeracy skills. Our early years curriculum supports the establishment and strengthening of well-being, emotional maturity, language development, thinking skills, curiosity, creativity and social and physical growth.

PRIMARY YEARS

In our primary school every girl is known, her strengths are catered for and she is supported and challenged to be the best she can be. Our teachers use data, together with an understanding of each student, to provide every girl with personalised care and attention.

Primary students are involved in whole school events and activities led by our secondary girls, promoting whole school focus on care and connection.

MIDDLE YEARS

In Years 7, 8 and 9, the middle phase of learning, our girls establish a broad base of skills and knowledge, to become successful learners, critical thinkers, confident and creative individuals. We build a foundation on which the girls can grow to be intellectually curious willing to persist and persevere, in preparing them for their senior secondary phase of learning.

SENIOR YEARS

Success in Years 7 to 9 provides students with the strong foundation they need for Years 10 -12, where the focus on academic achievement evolves as subjects become more specialised and increasingly complex.

Girls Grammar provides students with the broad set of skills critical to success in further education and life, including resilience, self-advocacy, critical and creative thinking, and a value for lifelong learning.

experience

At Girls Grammar, our boarding students are expertly cared for by experienced boarding staff, promoting clever, confident and connected young women. Girls Grammar offers boarding from Years 6-12, where we focus on maintaining a happy and harmonious environment that supports every girls' success in their interpersonal and educational development. As a learning environment, study is a priority with supervised study sessions each week from Sunday to Thursday, under the supervision and care of boarding supervisors and tutors.

While learning is a priority, so is student well-being. Boarders can relax with weekend group outings as well as making use of school facilities such as the pool, multi-purpose court, gymnasium, music practice room and library. Nutritious meals are prepared daily by our qualified resident chef and health needs are seen to by our on-site registered nurse in our Health Centre.

Our boarders enjoy spacious rooms, with senior students residing in single rooms and Years 6-9 sharing double rooms, with kitchenette and common room facilities available on each floor. With the added convenience of being right on the school campus, there's so much to love about being a boarder at Girls Grammar.
